IAA-IARI National Seminar Charts Roadmap for Transforming IARI into a World-Class Institution



The IARI Alumni Association (IAA), in collaboration with ICAR-Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), New Delhi, successfully organised a two-day National Seminar on "IARI Towards a World-Class Higher Education Institution" on 29-30 September 2025 at the NASC Complex, New Delhi. The event brought together approximately 100 distinguished scientists, policymakers, academicians, industry leaders, and young researchers to deliberate on strategies to elevate IARI's global stature in higher education, research, and innovation.

Inaugural remarks by Dr. M. L. Jat (Director General, ICAR) underscored the importance of holistic and multidisciplinary education, while Dr. R. S. Paroda (President, IAA) highlighted IARI's legacy as a land-grant institution and called for curriculum revamps, global collaborations, and quality enhancement to position IARI among the world's top universities. Dr. Ch. Srinivasa Rao



(Director, IARI) outlined a strategic roadmap focusing on world-class infrastructure and capacity building, and Dr. Anupama Singh (Joint Director, IARI) presented a detailed SWOT analysis to guide future transformation. International perspectives were shared by Prof. Kadambot Siddique (University of Western Australia), Dr. R.S. Kanwar (Former Vice-Chancellor, LPU) and Dr. K. Maredia (Michigan State University), emphasizing innovation, entrepreneurship, and global partnerships as key drivers.

Key recommendations emerging from the seminar included developing state-of-the-art infrastructure, revising curricula for interdisciplinary research, forging international academic partnerships, strengthening industry-academia linkages, instituting incentives for excellence, and launching capacity-building programmes to nurture future academic and scientific leadership. A Youth Forum and Essay Competition further engaged young faculty and students in envisioning IARI's future trajectory.

IAA-IARI Lecture on Entrepreneurship for Agricultural Graduates

Secretary's Report

The last six months were a very noteworthy period in the progress of IAA establishment. Under the dynamic guidance of Dr. Paroda, President, IAA and support provided by Dr. Ch. Srinivasa Rao, Chief Patron, and Dr. Anupama Singh, Patron, the office, inaugurated on April 15, 2025, has now become fully functional with all modern amenities that are needed for efficient functioning. The Executive Committee and Local Office Bearers meetings were held frequently to review the progress and plan new activities. In view of the current need for increasing the involvement of the corporate sector, the EC decided to nominate an alumnus from that sector by nominating Dr. S. Baskar Reddy from Syngenta to the EC. The Alumni Directory, an important activity is being continuously updated and the database already has more than 6500 alumni listed but more updating is required. We hope that with everyone's support the number will soon cross 7000. IAA has been able to make some progress towards opening a FCRA account for our foreign donors and we are hopeful of generating more resources to help us to multiply our activities.



A major recommendation of the seminar held on June 22, 2024 was to organize a national level meet to discuss, deliberate and develop an action plan for IARI to achieve a global status. This was executed by organizing a National Seminar on September 29-30, 2025 entitled "IARI Towards a World Class Higher Education Institution" with generous financial support from ICAR. About one hundred participants representing eminent scientists, policymakers, international experts and young minds met online and offline for two days to deliberate on this focused theme. The outcome is being published as a document entitled "IARI towards a World-Class Higher Education

Institution - A Way Forward". This will be in addition to the proceedings of the seminar.

In the next six months, we hope to continue with the IAA Lecture Series, conduct an awareness program on agriculture for school students, provide mentorship support to alumni entrepreneurs, initiate IAA-IARI awards for students and faculty, set up some regional chapters, and many more including resource generation efforts.
